Product Description

A highly developed oenological tannin product of highest purity. Tannivin® is exclusively of botanical origin. It is produced on the basis of selected French special woods, which means, only selected air-dried heart wood materials are applied for manufacture. Gentle extraction processes provide the necessary efficiency and purity. Tannivin® is a fine brown powder, its tannin content comes up to 65-75 %. The application of Tannivin® is permitted according to EU laws and regulations presently in force and complies with the purity regulations of the International Codex for wine treatment agents of the OIV. Tannivin® is certified by the laboratory of „Repression des Fraudes“ at Bordeaux.

Aim of Treatment

In wine treatment, tannin is a traditional product which has already been applied for many years. Tannivin® optimizes the precipitation potential of the wines, necessary for later protein finings.

Dosage

Red wine	2-20 g/100 L
White wine	1-10 g/100 L

A pre-test is recommended. Also in case of subsequent treatments with protein containing clarifiers, e.g. isinglass or gelatin, pre-tests should be carried out first to determine the degree of clarification and possible influences on the flavour.

Application

Tannivin® is applied in the young wine, preferably after the first racking and after completed malo-lactic fermentation. If required, later treatments are also possible. Tannivin® is added directly to the wine. It can be dissolved in some water and is then added to the total quantity of wine. Mix thoroughly. Low oxygenation in the course of addition promotes the effect of the product.

Storage

Store Tannivin® in a light-protected place and protect from influences of moisture and foreign odours. Reseal opened packagings immediately and tightly.
