**Information referring to Regulations EC 1829/2003 and EC 1830/2003 on labelling, permission and traceability of genetically modified foodstuffs and feedstuffs**

Dear customer

With this letter, we would like to inform you that for all products offered and sold under Erbslöh label applies that they are not subject to compulsory labelling according to the EU Regulations EC 1829/2003 and EC 1830/2003 on labelling, permission and traceability of genetically modified foodstuffs and feedstuffs.

On the one hand, this is based on the fact that the greatest part of our products, as for instance enzymes, silica sols, activated carbons etc., are technical aids\* and are therefore not subject to the above cited EU-regulations or, on the other hand that the products are neither genetically modified organisms themselves (GMO) nor do they contain genetically modified organisms, nor are they produced "from" or "by the use" of genetically modified organisms.

To assure you that products in respect of the prohibition of genetically modified organisms comply with the provisions of Regulation (EC) No 834/2007 on organic production, we also had the relevant enzyme products, yeasts and yeast nutrients registered under this subject in the data base under [www.infoXgen.com](http://www.infoXgen.com). For each of the products a respective compliance agreement is listed.
